Washington D.C. --- U.S. Representative Nick J. Rahall, (D-4th), has expressed his strong support for the Logan County Solid Waste Management Project in a letter to the Appalachian Regional Commission.

Rahall said, "The Logan County Solid Waste Management Project is a system designed to meet the needs of the county-wide garbage disposal. This pilot project will set a model for other counties, but more important, will set a model for our timber, coal and other industries which will allow them to convert their carbon bearing to energy at or near the mine site and to produce the energy to convert their acid and waste bearing water to pure water and solid usable waste."

Congressman Rahall's letter was sent to the Federal Co-chairman of the Appalachian Regional Commission, Robert Scott.

Rahall expects a reply from the ARC on the status of the project within the next few weeks.
