STATEMENT RE: DRAFT EVADERS PARDON BY PRESIDENT CARTER

I RESPECT PRESIDENT CARTER FOR FOLLOWING THROUGH ON HIS PROMISE
TO PARDON DRAFT EVADERS. HE HAS MADE A COMMITMENT TO SET FORTH A NEW
SPIRIT FOR THE NATION, AND I FEEL HIS VICTORY ON NOV. 2, PROVED THAT A
