WASHINGTON D.C. --- FOURTH DISTRICT CONGRESSMAN NICK J. RAHALL, (D-4TH) HAS EXPRESSED RENEWED HOPE IN SEEING HIS LEGI-ALTION PASSED THIS YEAR TO DESIGNATE A SEGMENT OF THE NEW RIVER GORGE AREA, A NATIONAL RIVER.

CONGRESSMAN

RAHALL INTRODUCED, HR 12001, EARLY THIS YEAR. THE MEASURE IS CO-SPONSORED BY CONGRESSMAN HARLEY O. STAGGERS, (D-2ND).

"I HAVE DISCUSSED THIS MEASURE WITH REP. PHILIP BURTON, (D-CAL), WHO IS THE CHAIRMAN OF THE HOUSE NATIONAL PARKS AND INSULAR AFFAIRS SUBCOMMITTEE," CONGRESSMAN RAHALL POINTED OUT, "AND HE HAS OF-FERED HIS SUPPORT FOR THE BILL."

RAHALL STATED THAT, "IN DISCUSSIONS WITH MY COLLEAGUES ON THE NEW RIVER BILL, I HAVE FOUND A GREAT AWARENESS OF THE SCENIC BEAUTY THIS REGION POSSESSES, AND THE NEED TO PROTECT AND PRESERVE IT FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS."

CONGRESSMAN RAHALL POINTED OUT THAT HEARINGS COULD BE HELD SOMETIME BEFORE MID-SEPTEMBER, WITH HOUSE ACTION COMING SOON THEREAFTER. "I BELIEVE IT IS/VERY IMPORTANT FOR ALL THOSE AFFECTED ONE WAY OR ANOTHER BY THIS LEGISLATION, TO HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO EXPRESS THEIR SUPPORT OR CONCERN."

RAHALL OBSERVED THAT TWO MAJOR QUESTIONS STILL MUST BE DEALT WITH BEFORE HR 12001 CAN BE APPROVED. "FIRST IS THE QUESTION OF COST. WE NEED TO BE SURE THAT THE APPROPRIATED FUNDS WILL BE SUFFICIENT TO PROTECT THAT AREA," RAHALL SAID. "SECONDLY, THERE STILL REMAINS A QUESTION AS TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE GORGE AREA. I HOPE BOTH OF THESE MATTERS CAN BE RESOLVED IN THE HEARINGS."
