Beckley, WV --- Wednesday, April 12, will mark, "Nick Rahall Day" in McDowell County. The Fourth District United States Congressman will make one of his many campaign swings through McDowell County all day on April 12.

Congressman Rahall's day will be capped with a speech before the Welch Lions Club.

Congressman Rahall stated that he looks forward to his trip through the county, "I really enjoy spending time with all of my good friends in McDowell, and I hope to see as many of them as possible on April 12."

Rahall expects a good margin in McDowell County in his upcoming campaign for re-election to the United States House of
Representatives. In his 1976 election to Congress, Rahall polled
twice as many votes than his nearest opponent in the southern West
Virginia county.

Congressman Rahall's visit to McDowell County, is just a part of the intensive schedule he has been undertaking in the last few weeks.
