Beckley, West Virginia --- Fourth District Congressman Nick J. Rahall, (D-WV), will take part in the Congressional Hearings on Veterar Health Care problems in Beckley on Wed. Jan. 11. The hearings will be headed up by Senator Jennings Randolph, (D-WV).
