"THE SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION WANTS TO BE AVAILABLE FOR ANY QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS RESIDENTS MAY HAVE IN REGARDS TO THEIR DISASTER LOANS," RAHALL SAID. "I FEEL ENCOURAGED THAT S.B.A. IS SHOWING AN INTEREST IN THE EFFECT THESE LOANS HAVE HAD ON THE AREA, BECAUSE THIS MONEY PROVIDED A MUCH-NEEDED BOOST TO FAMILIES AND BUSINESSMEN WHO WERE VICTIMS OF THE APRIL, 1977 FLOOD," CONGRESSMAN RAHALL CONCLUDED.
