WASHINGTON D.C. --- WEST VIRGINIA'S FOURTH DISTRICT CONGRESS-MAN NICK J. RAHALL, HAS ANNOUNCED THAT SURPLUS H.U.D. MOBILE HOMES HAVE BEEN MADE AVAILABLE TO THE CRUM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FOR USE AS SPECIAL EDUCATION CLASSROOMS.

"AFTER CONTACTING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS, WE WERE ABLE TO OBTAIN 6 SURPLUS MOBILE HOMES AT A REDUCED PRICE, FOR USE BY THE SCHOOL," RAHALL SAID. "THESE MOBILE HOMES WILL BE RENOVATED AND FIRE-PROOFED FOR USE AS CLASSROOMS."

THE CONGRESSMAN STATED THAT THREE OF MOBILE HOMES WILL USED AT THE CRUM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, WITH THE OTHERS BEING USED AT VARIOUS OTHER LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT WAYNE COUNTY.

CONGRESSMAN RAHALL PRAISED THE WORK OF CRUM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PRINCIPAL RALPH DAWSON FOR HIS WORK ON THIS PROJECT.

"MR. DAWSON WAS WELL AWARE OF THE NEED FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION CLASSROOMS, AND THROUGH OUR COMBINED EFFORTS, WE WERE ABLE TO OB-TAIN THE NEEDED FACILITIES," RAHALL STATED.

THREE MOBILE HOMES HAVE ALREADY BEEN DELIVERED, WITH THE 3 OTHERS TO BE PICKED UP SOON.
