"I LOOK FORWARD TO THIS OPPORTUNITY TO COMPARE NOTES ON THE COAL SITUATION WITH MEMBERS OF THE COAL COMMISSION," RAHALL STATED, "AND I KNOWSMY COLLEAGUES WILL WELCOME THES COORDINATION OF OUR EFFORTS."
