WASHINGTON D.C. --- WEST VIRGINIA'S FOURTH DISTRICT CONGRESS-MAN NICK J. RAHALL, HAS URGED THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT TO EXPEDITE \$760,000 INTO THE HUNTINGTON AREA, TO BE USED AS A RESULT OF RECENT FLOODING IN THE KROUT'S CREEK-WESTMORE-LAND REGION.
