WEST VIRGINIA'S FOURTH DISTRICT CONGRESSMAN NICK J. RAHALL, OF BECKLEY, WILL BE IN PARKERSBURG ON SATURDAY, AUGUST 29, TO ATTEND THE ANNUAL WOOD COUNTY DEMOCRATIC OX ROAST.

CONGRESSMAN RAHALL IS CURRENTLY SERVING HIS THIRD TERM IN THE UNITED STATES HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES. WHEN HE WAS ELECTED TO CONGRESS IN 1976, AT THE AGE OF 27, HE WAS THE YOUNGEST MEMBER OF THE HOUSE AT THAT TIME.

AS FOUNDER AND CHAIRMAN OF THE CONGRESSIONAL COAL GROUP, CONGRESSMAN RAHALL HAS BECOME A CHIEF SPOKESMAN FOR COAL IN THE NATION'S CAPITOL. RAHALL ALSO IS A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEES ON PUBLIC WORKS AND TRANSPORTATION, INTERIOR AND INSULAR AFFAIRS, AND STANDARDS OF OFFICIAL CONDUCT.
