COAL GROUP TO MEET ON CLEAN AIR ACT

WASHINGTON D.C. --- WEST VIRGINIA'S FOURTH DISTRICT CONGRESSMAN NICK J. RAHALL, HAS CALLED A MEETING OF THE CONGRESSIONAL COAL GROUP ON THE REAUTHORIZATION OF THE CLEAN AIR ACT.

THE MEETING WILL BE HELD, THURSDAY, JUNE 18, IN 2253 RAYBURN HOUSE OFFICE BUILDING, AT 2PM. THE MEETING IS OPEN.

"PERHAPS THE MOST IMPORTANT ISSUE FACING CONGRESS THIS YEAR PERTAINING BOTH TO THE FUTURE OF COAL AND THE ELECTRIC UTILITY INDUSTRY, IS THE CLEAN AIR ACT," RAHALL OBSERVED, "AND I BELIEVE IT IS IMPORTANT THAT ALL MEMBERS OF THE COAL GROUP BE KNOWLEDGEABLE AS TO POSSIBLE CHANGES IN THE BASIC PROVISIONS OF THE ACT AND HOW THEY AFFECT THE PRODUCTION AND UTILIZATION OF COAL."

PRESENTATIONS WILL BE MADE BY INDIVIDUALS REPRESENTING, THE EDISON ELECTRIC INSTITUTE, CONSOL, NATIONAL COAL ASSOCIATION, BITUMINOUS COAL RESEARCH, AND PEABODY COAL.

THE MEETING IS LIMITED TO ONE HOUR.
