WASHINGTON D.C. --- WEST VIRGINIA'S FOURTH DISTRICT  
CONGRESSMAN NICK J. RAHALL, HAS ANNOUNCED THAT NOVEMBER 25,  
1980, IS THE DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS TO THE NATION'S FIVE  
MILITARY ACADEMIES.

"ANY YOUNG MAN OR WOMAN INTERESTED IN ATTENDING THE MILI-  
TARY, NAVAL, AIR FORCE, MERCHANT MARINE, OR COAST GUARD ACA-  
DEMY, SHOULD CONTACT MY OFFICE BEFORE NOVEMBER 25," RAHALL  
POINTED OUT.

CONGRESSMAN RAHALL SAID THAT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS  
NEEDED BY HIM TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE ACADEMIES: DATE  
OF BIRTH, DATE OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION, AND SOCIAL SECURITY  
NUMBER. THIS MATERIAL SHOULD BE SENT TO CONGRESSMAN RAHALL'S  
WASHINGTON D.C. OFFICE. THE ADDRESS IS: 408 CANNON HOUSE  
OFFICE BUILDING, WASHINGTON D.C. 20515.

"THIS EARLY DEADLINE IS SET," RAHALL STATED, "TO PROVIDE  
HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES IN SOUTHERN WEST VIRGINIA WITH THE BEST  
POSSIBLE CHANCE OF FAVORABLE CONSIDERATION BY THE ACADEMIES."

CONGRESSMAN RAHALL ALSO POINTED OUT THAT 17 YOUNG PEOPLE  
FROM SOUTHERN WEST VIRGINIA HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED TO THE MILITARY  
ACADEMIES IN THE LAST THREE YEARS.

"SOUTHERN WEST VIRGINIA HAS A PROUD HISTORY OF PROVIDING  
TOP-NOTCH INDIVIDUALS TO THE MILITARY SERVICE, AND I AM CON-  
FIDENT THAT WE WILL AGAIN PRESENT AN INTELLIGENT AND CAPABLE  
CROP OF ACADEMY NOMINEES AGAIN THIS YEAR," CONGRESSMAN RAHALL  
OBSERVED.
