WASHINGTON D.C. --- WEST VIRGINIA'S FOURTH DISTRICT CONGRESSMAN NICK J. RAHALL, ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE TOWN OF FORT GAY HAS BEEN APPROVED A NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE CORPS SITE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, EDUCATION AND WELFARE.
