WATER SYSTEM IN BEECH FORK LAKE AREA NEARING COMPLETION

WASHINGTON D.C. --- WEST VIRGINIA'S FOURTH DISTRICT CONGRESS-MAN NICK J. RAHALL, HAS ANNOUNCED THAT THE ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS IS ABOUT 2 WEEKS AWAY FROM COMPLETING THE WATER SUPPLY LINE TO THE RESIDENTS OF THE BEECH FORK LAKE AREA IN CABELL COUNTY.

"THIS IS VERY GOOD NEWS TO THE PEOPLE IN THIS REGION OF CABELL COUNTY," CONGRESSMAN RAHALL STATED, "BECAUSE THIS IS A PROJECT THAT HAS TAKEN NEARLY 5 YEARS TO FINISH."

RAHALL, WHO HAS HELD A NUMBER OF MEETINGS WITH THE CORPS AND RESIDENTS OF THE AREA DURING THE COURSE OF THE PROJECT, POINTED OUT THAT, "FOR SEVERAL YEARS THE STATE HAS HAD TO TRUCK WATER INTO THE BEECK FORK LAKE REGION, AND NOW THIS EXTENSIVE EFFORT CAN BE HALTED AS THE RESIDENTS WILL BENEFIT FROM THEIR OWN WATER SYSTEM."

IN HIS COMMUNICATIONS WITH CORPS OFFICIALS, RAHALL EXPLAINED
THAT A FEW MINOR PROBLEMS NEED TO BE CLEARED UP IN THE NEXT FEW
WEEKS TO FINALIZE THE PROJECT. "IT'S AN EFFORT THAT IS LONG OVERDUE, AND I HOPE THE PEOPLE WILL BE PLEASED WITH THE RESULTS," THE
CONGRESSMAN CONCLUDED.
