RAHALL TO TESTIFY ON MINE SAFETY

WASHINGTON D.C. --- WEST VIRGINIA'S FOURTH DISTRICT CONGRESSMAN NICK J. RAHALL, WILL TESTIFY BEFORE THE HOUSE GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS SUBCOMMITTEE ON MANPOWER ON THE SUBJECT OF MINE

"I AM CONCERNED WITH THE TREND THAT IS TAKING PLACE WITH REGARD TO MINE SAFETY," RAHALL OBSERVED.
