Unemployment in our State is nearing the 10 percent figure. In some of the coal producing counties of southern West Virginia, unemployment over 20 percent.

To meet this situation, I have introduced a measure in the House of Representatives that would stimulate the use of a large untapped source of federal funds—to put unemployed coal miners and construction workers back to work.

The legislation--which is entitled: The Coal Mining and Construction Job Stimulas Act, would use moneis from the Abandoned Mire Reclmation Fund to hire out-of-work coal miners and construction employees to carry out of the task of reclaiming abandoned coal mine land.

This bill, HR 7242, will serve a double benefit to our State:

(1) Jobs, and (2) the maintenance of our Mountain beauty.
