THIS MEASURE WILL BE OF NO ADDITIONAL BURDEN TO THE AMERICAN
TAXPAYERS, BECAUSE I PROPOSE THAT THE READJUSTMENTS BENEFITS BE
PAID FROM TARIFFS LEVIED ON FOREIGN STEEL. IT SEEMS ONLY FAIR THAT
IF IMPORTS ARE GOING TO LEAD TO MASSIVE LAY-OFFS, THEN THOSE
