FOR THIS REASON, I HAVE CO-SPONSORED AND AM ACTIVLY SUPPORTING LEGISLATION ENTITLED THE SMALL BUSINESS INNOVATION DEVELPMENT ACT. THIS MEASURE WOULD SET ASIDE A SMALL PORTION OF THE MASSIVE FEDERAL RESERACH AND DEVELOPMENT BUDGET TO PROMOTE INNOVATIVE IDEAS BY SMALL BUSINESS FIRMS.

ALREADY THE BILL HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE HOUSE SMALL BUSINESS COMMITTEE, AND IS AWAITING FLOOR ACTION. THE SENATE KAKIKRX PASSED THE MEASURE IN DECEMBER, BY A VOTE OF 90-0.

THIS IMPORTANT SMALL BUSINESS LEGISLATION WILL BE A BOOM FOR NEW AMERICAN TECHNOLOGY, AND CREATE JOBS---TWO IMPORTANT FACTORS IN AMERICA'S ECONOMIC RECOVERY.
