SERIOUS QUESTIONS ARE BEING ASKED BY CONCERNED CITIZENS IN APPALACHIA WITH RESPECT TO THIS ISSUE. ARE THE REDUCTIONS IN MSHA PERSONNEL AND REDUCED INSPECTION ACTIVITY AFFECTING THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THE COAL LABOR FORCE? AND IF SO, COULD THE RECENT RASH OF COAL MINE DISASTERS, WHICH RESULTED IN THE DEATHS OF 56 MEN OVER A TWO MONTH PERIOD, COULD HAVE POSSIBLY BEEN AVIODED OR AT LEAST ATTICATED. THE ISSUE OF MINE SAFETY, EOR I DELIEVE, IF MISTAKES ARE NOT RECTIFYIED AND LINGERING QUESTIONS ABOUT MINE SAFETY ARE NOT ANSWERED, FURTHER DISASTER MAY INDEED OCCUR.
