RAHALL ADDRESSES SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENTS CONFERENCE

CANAAN VALLEY, WV --- IN HIS REMARKS TO THE WEST VIRGINIA
SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENTS ANNUAL CONFERENCE, WEST VIRGINIA'S FOURTH
DISTRICT CONGRESSMAN NICK J. RAHALL STRESSED THAT, "SCHOOL FUNCTIONS SHOULD AND MUST BE SUPPLEMENTED WITH VOLUNTARY EFFORTS BY
PRIVATE AND PUBLIC COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS."

"THE UNITED STATES NEEDS A NATIONAL STRATEGY FOR EDUCATION

AND TRAINING," RAHALL POINTED OUT, "AND TO SAY THAT THIS RESPONSI
BILITY RESTS EXCLUSIVELY WITH THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS, IS UNFAIR AND UN
REALISTIC."

CONGRESSMAN RAHALL EXPLAINED THAT, "THERE MUST BE A CONCERTED

EFFORT FROM DIFFERENT LEVELS OF GOVERNMENT AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR TO

DEMONSTRATE A CONCERN AND A RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE EDUCATIONAL DEVELOP
MENT OF OUR YOUNG PEOPLE."

"UNLESS WE REBUILD THE AMERICAN ECONOMY AND STRENGTHEN OUR EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM, IT WILL BE INCREASINGLY DIFFICULT--IF NOT IMPOSSIBLE-TO MAINTAIN A HIGH STANDARD OF LIVING FOR ALL AMERICANS, AND PROVIDE
FOR A STRONG NATIONAL DEFENSE," RAHALL WARNED.

RAHALL OBSERVED, "WHILE I HAVE MY DISAGREEMENTS WITH PRESIDENT REAGAN ON HIS APPROACH TO EDUCATION, I HAVE TO HONESTLY SAY THAT HE HAS HELPED IN PUSHING EDUCATION TO THE FOREFRONT OF THE NATION'S CONSCIOUSNESS."

"HOWEVER," CONGRESSMAN RAHALL STATED, "I AM CONCERNED THAT THE PRESIDENT THINKS ONLY OF MILITARY VULNERABILITY, AND NOT OF THE VULNERABILITY OF A NATION ILL-EDUCATED FOR THE COMPUTER AGE."

"THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SHOULD BE A SUPPORTING PARTNER IN OUR NATION'S EDUCATION SYSTEM," CONGRESSMAN RAHALL STATED. "IT SHOULD PROVIDE HELP BEYOND WHAT THE STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS ARE ABLE TO PROVIDE THEMSELVES," RAHALL CONCLUDED.
