A SITUATION WHICH IS TOTALLY UNACCEPTABLE.

THEREFORE, I HAVE JOINED WITH A NUMBER OF MY COLLEAGUES IN
THE CONGRESS, TO GUARANTEE THAT THE SOCIAL SECURITY DISABLITY REVIEW
PROCESS IS CARRIED OUT WITH CARE, AND COMMON SENSE.

THE FINANCIAL SOLVENCY OF THE PROGRAM, BUT IT DEMORALIZES THOSE SO NON-RECIPIENTS WHO ARE DESERVING OF BENEFITS. IF A PERSON MEETS THE PROPER CRITERIA, THEY SHOULD HAVE NO FEAR THAT THEIR BENEFITS WILL BE TERMINIED.
