THIS IS CONGRESSMAN NICK RAHALL.

A FEW MONTHS AGO, I DISCUSSED AN IMPORTANT LEGISLATIVE EFFORT THAT I HAD JOINED. TODAY, I AM HAPPY TO REPORT THAT IT IS MOVING SPEEDILY ALONG TO POSSIBLE PASSAGE BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

I AM REFERRING TO THE HEALTH CARE FOR THE UNEMPLOYED ACT, A MEASURE WHICH IS OF UTMOST IMPORTANCE TO THE PEOPLE OF SOUTHERN WEST VIRGINIA.

THIS BILL ADDRESSES A PROBLEM THAT WE HAVE BECOME ALL TOO FAMILIER WITH, AND DOES SO IN A REASONABLE AND AFFORDABLE WAY.

IT WOULD ENTITLE PEOPLE RECEIVING UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION, AND THEIR FAMLIES, AS WELL AS THOSE WHO HAVE LOST THEIR UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION BENEFITS IN THE PAST 72 YEARS, TO COVERAGE FOR BASIC HEALTH CARE SERVICES. THE PROGRAM WOULD BE OPTIONAL TO STATES, IF THEY CHOOSE TO PARTICIPATE, AND FEDERAL MATCHING DOLLARS WOULD BE MADE AVAILABLE AT A RATE THAT INCREASED AS THE STATE'S TOTAL UNEMPLOYMENT RATE INCREASED.

HERE IN WEST VIRGINIA, WE CAN CERTAINLY USE SUCH A PROGRAM, AND THAT IS WHY I AM SUPPORTING IT---TO ADDRESS AN IMMEDIATE AND SEVERE NEED FOR HEALTH CARE.
