DAUMIER COLLECTION TO BE DISPLAYED AT THE HUNTINGTON GALLERIES

WASHINGTON D.C. --- WEST VIRGINIA'S FOURTH DISTRICT CONGRESSMAN, HAS BEEN INFORMED IN A LETTER FROM MR. ARMAND HAMMER, THAT THE PRIZED COLLECTION OF DAUMIER PRINTS WILL BE EXHIBITED IN THE NEAR FUTURE AT THE HUNTINGTON GALLERIES.
