THIS IS CONGRESSMAN NICK RAHALL.

LAST WEEK, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES APPROVED A SUPPORTER MEASURE THAT I WAS A CO-SPONSOR AND STRONG %MRRORX OF -- THE SOCIAL SECURITY DISABILITY REFORM ACT.

NO DOUBT DISABLITY CASES MUST BE REVIEWED FROM TIME TO TIME, HOWEVER THE CURRENT PROCEDURE USED IS UNFAIR AND IMPERSONAL.

DURING THE NUMEROUS MEETINGS I HAVE HAD WITH CONSTITUENTS, WHO HAVE BEEN HURT BY THE TERMINATION OF THEIR DISABILITY CLAIMS, I HAVE SEEN THE AGONY, STRESS AND PAIN THEY HAVE GONE THROUGH.

THE BILL CONGRESS PASSED LAST WEEK, IN MY JUDGEMENT, PUTS COMMON SENSE AND FAIRNESS INTO THE DISABILITY REVIEW PROCESS.

THE PROVISIONS CONTAINED THIS LEGISLATION WXKK SET CLEAR MEDICAL AND PROCEDURAL STANDARDS THAT THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION MUST FOLLOW BEFORE ANY DISABILITY BENEFITS ARE TERMINATED.
