MANY OF THESE PEOPLE WERE POOR TO ELDERLY AND HANDICAPPED AND DEPEND ON THEIR TELEPHONE FOR CONTACT WITH THEIR DOCTORS AND THE IN ORDER TO ERADICATE THIS PROBLEM, I RECENTLY COSPONSORED LEGISLATION IN CONGRESS THAT WOULD ESTABLISH SPECIAL LIFE-LINE RATES FOR LOW-INCOME RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS. THIRTY-FIVE PERCENT OF THE ELDERLY WHO MAKE LESS THAN \$8,000 A YEAR HAVE HAD TO CUT THEIR PHONE USE SUBSTANTIALLY. ONE OF EVERY FIVE AMERICANS OVER THE AGE OF 55 HAVE EITHER HAD TO CUT THEIR USE OR CANCEL THEIR PHONE SERVICE.

WE MUST PROTECT OUR ELDERLY AND HANDICAPPED BY ALLOWING THEM ACCESS TO THEIR LIFELINE-- THEIR TELEPHONE.
