Rahall Schedules Area Speaking Engagements

Washington, D.C. -- Fourth District Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV) will be speaking to the National League of Postmasters State Meeting and to the West Virginia Associated Press Broadcasters Convention this weekend in West Virginia.

The Annual State Meeting of the National League of Postmasters is meeting at the Ramada Inn in Beckley, W. Va., and Congressman Rahall will address the postmasters at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, June 28, 1985.

The West Virginia Associated Press Broadcasters Convention is being held at Pipestem State Park and Congressman Rahall will address the convention at 12:30 p.m. on Saturday, June 29, 1985.

Congressman Rahall will also participate in the Placement Ceremony of a bronze statue depicting the modern-day miner at the National Mine Health and Safety Academy in Beckley on Monday, July 8, 1985, at 9:30 a.m. "The bronze statue, standing 6 feet, 8 inches tall, is called 'The Miner' and it is an inspiring tribute to today's miner and I believe will serve as such to the members of the mining community who visit and attend the Academy," Rep. Rahall said.

Rep. Rahall will also appear on the March of Dimes Telethon this weekend on WVAH-TV, Channel 23. "This marks the first year that the local telethon has been a part of the national broadcast, and I see this is a tribute to the people of our area being recognized as one of the leading states in the nation when it comes to helping the March of Dimes," Rep. Rahall pointed out.
