Rahall Announces Federal Emergency Money for Fourth District

Washington, D.C. -- Fourth District Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV) today that his Congressional District will receive \$86,772 to supplement emergency food and shelter programs from the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

"We are receiving this money under Public Law 99-88 which was passed to of continue the provision of Emergency Food and Shelter to needy individuals. Grant awards from this program are designed to address emergency food and shelter needs," Rep. Rahall explained. "This money is not intended to address or correct structural poverty or long-standing problems. Rather, this appropriation is for the purchase of food and shelter, to supplement and extend current available resources and not to substitute or reimburse ongoing programs."
