RAHALL TO FILE FOR RE-ELECTION ON FRIDAY

Washington, D.C. -- Fourth District Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV) will file for re-election to a sixth term on Friday, January 24, 1986, at 10:00 a.m., in the Secretary of State's Office in Charleston.
