ENDORSEMENTS REFLECT WIDE RANGE OF RAHALL SUPPORT

Huntington, W. Va. -- Rep. Nick Rahall says that the recent endorsement of his candidacy by many organizations reflecting various segments of society is an indication of the wide range of support he enjoys in West Virginia in his bid for a sixth term in the U.S. House of Representatives.

Rahall was recently endorsed by the United Mine Workers of America's COMPAC; the National Association of Social Workers; the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME); the West Virginia Education Association; the Amalgamated Transit Union; the National Federation of Federal Employees; the Brotherhood of Railway, Airline and Steamship Clerks (BRAC); and the Railway Labor Executives Association, a voluntary association of 18 national and international railway labor organizations representing the working men and women of the railroad industry; as well as other endorsements

In addition, Rahall was recently awarded a 100% voting rating by the National Council of Senior Citizens.
