On Saturday, December 13, at 11:00 am, Rep. Rahall will be appearing at the Toys for Tots party at the Welch pizza Hut. In keeping with the spirit of the season, Rep. Rahall will be bringing along a station wagon full of toys and children's clothing for distribution to the children there. "I applaud the dedication of the people organizing the Toys for Tots campaign and it is my privilege to be able to join them in Welch," Rep. Rahall said. "I am hopeful that my contribution along with those of the many, many good-hearted citizens of McDowell County will help make this a merry Christmas for the children of West Virginia."
