## RAHALL SAYS FEMA TO AWARD \$746,890.32 TO WEST VIRGINIA

Washington, D.C. -- West Virginia has been awarded \$746,890.32 by the Federal Emergency Management Agency to extend and supplement emergency food and shelter services, according to U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV).

"Twenty-nine of our 55 counties qualified under FEMA criteria for aid under the auspices of the Emergency Food and Shelter National Board Program, a division of FEMA," Rep. Rahall said. "In addition, \$56,516.32 has been set aside to allow greater flexibility in selection of needy jurisdictions and is intended to target pockets of homelessness or poverty in non-qualifying areas, areas experiencing drastic economic changes such as plant closings, and areas with high levels of unemployment."
