RAHALL SAYS CONTRACT AWARDED FOR WORK ON TUG FORK

WASHINGTON - U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-W.Va.) said today he has been informed that a contract in the estimated amount of \$182,000 has been awarded for Williamson Area Clearing on the Tug Fork River.

"The Small Business Administration in Bala Cynwyd, Pennsylvania has received the contract for the work near Williamson," Rahall said. "They in turn have contacted a subcontractor within the state to perform the services."

Rahall said the subcontract for the work and services has been awarded to Tri-State Engineering and Management Consultant of New Martinsville, West Virginia.
