HUNTINGTON BOARD RECEIVES HOUSING ASSISTANCE FUNDS

LOGAN, W.Va. - U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall, in Logan today to celebrate the tenth anniversary of the Surface Mine Act at Chief Logan State Park, announced that the Huntington Human Relation Commission has been awarded a grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Rahall said the funds are authorized under the fair housing assistance program and total \$14,500. The Congressman said the award will help continue fair housing practices and investigate allegations of discrimination in housing.

"The program will provide funds to support the Human Relations Commission's housing discrimination complaint processing efforts," Rahall said. "It will also fund expenses associated with training of agency personnel in fair housing enforcement."
