RAHALL ANNOUNCES GRANT TO MARSHALL UNIVERSITY

WASHINGTON, DC - U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-W.Va.) announced today that the Marshall University College of Education has received a grant of \$76,676 from the U.S. Department of Education. According to Rahall, the funds will be used for the preparation of special education personnel.

"The purpose of this grant is to help improve the quality and increase the supply of special education teachers in West Virginia," Rahall said.

"The objective is to help educate future supervisors, administrators, researchers, speech correctionists and other personnel that include specialists in physical education and recreation."

The grant period will continue through June 30, 1988 and Rahall adds that the U.S. Department of Education will consider the continued funding of the project for 36 months if certain criteria outlined by the Department of Education are met.
