RAHALL SAYS SALT ROCK P.S.D. TO RECEIVE GRANT INCREASE

WASHINGTON, DC - U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-W.Va.) has announced that the Salt Rock Sewer Public Service District in Ona has received a grant increase from the Environmental Protection Agency.

According to the Congressman, the EPA has awarded the PSD an additional \$1,003,840 for the design and construction of a wastewater treatment facility.

"The additional funds provided by the EPA will allow the Salt Rock Sewer Public Service District to continue work on its facility," Rahall said. "It is very important that such wastewater projects are not only undertaken, but adequately funded so that we may preserve our environment for future generations."

The additional \$1,003,840 brings the total grant from the EPA for the project to \$5,407,420. The program is being funded under the authority of Title II of the Clean Water Act.
