

WEST VIRGINIA COLLEGES RECEIVE FEDERAL FUNDS TO AID STUDENTS

WASHINGTON, DC - U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-W.Va.) announced today that the U.S. Department of Education has approved awards to 34 West Virginia institutions of higher education participating in the College Work Study, The Supplemental Education Opportunity Grant, and The Perkins Loan Programs.

According to the Congressman, these funds will greatly assist many West Virginia students continue education beyond the high school level.

"Many students in West Virginia and throughout America do not have the funds to attend college," Rahall said. "Through the Work Study, Supplemental Education Opportunity Grants and the Perkins Loan Programs, there will be a chance for many to obtain post-secondary education."

The State of West Virginia will receive \$9,454,336 for the three programs which will serve 17,711 students at 34 institutions. Listed below is a breakdown of funds allocated:
