## RAHALL SAYS NO TO DRUGS!

WASHINGTON, DC - U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall has announced that he is taking action to combat America's drug problem by supporting legislation that would designate a week in which honor youth who are fighting drugs.

Rahall supports the Joint Resolution, which in addition to praising those who say "no", directs the President to designate May 17-23 as "Just Say No To Drugs Week."
