RAHALL SAYS CONTRACT AWARDED FOR WORK ON TUG FORK

WASHINGTON - U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-W.Va.) said today he has been informed that a contract in the estimated amount of \$182,000 has been awarded for Williamson Area Clearing on the Tug Fork River.

Rahall said the subcontract for the work and services has been awarded to Tri-State Engineering and Management Consultant of New Martinsville, West Virginia.
