SHADY SPRING PSD RECEIVES GRANT INCREASE

WASHINGTON, DC - U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-W.Va.) has announced that the Shady Spring Public Service District in Beaver has received a grant increase from the Environmental Protection Agency.

According to the Congressman, the EPA has awarded the PSD an additional \$3,668 for the design and construction of a wastewater treatment facility.

"The additional funding will allow the Shady Spring PSD to continue work on its facility," Rahall said. "It is very important that such waste facilities are constructed in order to preserve our environment."

The additional \$3,668 brings the total grant from the EPA to \$1,650,489. An additional \$57,953 is being granted by the Appalachian Regional Commission.
