RAHALL ANNOUNCES MARSHALL MEDICAL GRANT

WASHINGTON, DC - U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-W.Va.) announced today that the Marshall University School of Medicine has received a grant for over \$5,000 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

The award totals \$5,184 and will provide grants for faculty development in family medicine, a program Rahall calls vital to Appalachian Health Care.

"We need family doctors in our state," Rahall said. "This grant will enable those interested in such a practice to further develop their skills and talents in this life saving profession."

The award is authorized by Section 786-a of the Public Health Service Act and is for the period beginning July 1, 1987 and ending June 30, 1990.
