RAHALL SAYS CRAB ORCHARD/MACARTHUR PSD RECEIVES ADDITIONAL FUNDS

WASHINGTON - U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-W.Va.) announced today that the Crab Orchard/MacArthur Public Service District has been granted additional funding for its wastewater treatment facility.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has granted the PSD an additional \$384,450 which will aid in the design and construction of solids handling facilities and aerobic digester. Rahall praised the EPA's action saying such is necessary to preserve the environment.

"It is imperative that funds are provided to adequately preserve our environment," Rahall said. "If we do not do such we are endangering not only our own lives, but the lives of future generations."
