Rahall will begin the day with his first Voc-Ed Forum with students and faculty at the Southern Wayne County Vocational Education Center near Fort Gay. Rahall then heads south on U.S. Route 52 for a noon luncheon with the Williamson Chamber of Commerce to discuss his ARC bills introduced in the current session of Congress.
