A BILL

- To extend the Appalachian Regional Development Act of 1965 and to provide authorizations for the Appalachian Highway and Appalachian Area Development Programs.
 - Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
 - 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

- 1 That this Act may be cited as the `Appalachian Regional
- 2 Development Act Amendments of 1989 .
- 3 SEC. 2. Section 2(a) of the Appalachian Regional
- 4 Development Act of 1965 (40 U.S.C. App. 2) is amended by
- 5 striking out the period at the end of the sixth sentence and
- 6 inserting in lieu thereof the following: `and in severely
- 7 distressed and underdeveloped counties or areas lacking
- 8 resources for basic services. '.
- 9 SEC. 3. Subsection (b) of section 105 of the Appalachian
- 10 Regional Development Act of 1965 (40 U.S.C. App. 105(b)) is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 '(b) There are authorized to be appropriated to the
- 13 Commission to carry out the provisions of this section
- 14 \$3,500,000 for each of fiscal years 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993,
- 15 and 1994. Amounts appropriated pursuant to this subsection
- 16 shall remain until expended. Not more than \$1,000,000 of the
- 17 amounts appropriated pursuant to this subsection for each
- 18 fiscal year shall be available for expenses of the Federal
- 19 co-chairman, alternate, and the Federal staff. . .
- SEC. 4. Section 106(7) of the Appalachian Regional
- 21 Development Act of 1965 (40 U.S.C. App. 106(7)) is amended by
- 22 striking out `1982' and inserting in lieu thereof `1994'.
- SEC. 5. (a) Subsection (g) of section 201 of the
- 24 Appalachian Regional Development Act of 1965 (40 U.S.C. App.
- 25 201(g)) is amended to read as follows:

- 1 (g) There are authorized to be appropriated to carry
- 2 out the provisions of this section \$144,000,000 for each of
- 3 fiscal years 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993, and 1994. Such sums
- 4 shall remain available until expended. '.
- 5 (b)(1) Section 201(h)(1) of such Act is amended by
- 6 striking out `70 per centum' and inserting in lieu thereof
- 7 `80 percent'.
- 8 (2) The amendment made by paragraph (1) shall apply with
- 9 respect to projects approved after March 31, 1979.
- SEC. 6. Section 214(c) of the Appalachian Regional
- 11 Development Act of 1965 (40 U.S.C. App. 214(c)) is amended--
- 12 (1) by striking out. December 31, 1980 in the
- 13 first sentence and inserting in lieu thereof `September
- 14 30, 1994', and
- 15 (2) by inserting `authorized by title 23, United
- 16 States Code after road construction in the second
- 17 sentence.
- SEC. 7. Section 224(a)(1) of the Appalachian Regional
- 19 Development Act of 1965 (40 U.S.C. App. 224(a)(1)) is amended
- 20 by striking out the semicolon at the end thereof and
- 21 inserting in lieu thereof the following: `or in a severely
- 22 distressed and underdeveloped county or area lacking
- 23 resources for basic services; '.
- SEC. 8. Section 401 of the Appalachian Regional
- 25 Development Act of 1965 (40 U.S.C. App. 401) is amended to

- 1 read as follows:
- 2 "SEC. 401. In addition to the appropriations authorized
- 3 in section 105 for administrative expenses, and in section
- 4 201(g) for the Appalachian development highway system and
- 5 local access roads, there are authorized to be appropriated,
- 6 to remain available until expended, to carry out this Act,
- 7 \$37,500,000 for each of fiscal years 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993,
- 8 and 1994. ...
- 9 SEC. 9. Section 405 of the Appalachian Regional
- 10 Development Act of 1965 (40 U.S.C. App. 405) is amended by
- 11 striking out `1982' and inserting in lieu thereof `1994'.
