

The Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, which is a U.S. Department of Justice agency within the Office of Justice Programs, has awarded \$325,000 to the West Virginia Governor's Office of Community and Industrial Development to fund juvenile justice and delinquency prevention programs in that State through September 30, 1991.

The grant will support programs that develop, maintain, and expand juvenile delinquency prevention services; divert status and nonoffenders from the juvenile justice system; and provide community-based alternatives to confinement in secure detention and correctional facilities. In addition, these funds will be used for programs to improve sentencing procedures, provide resources necessary for informed dispositions, and provide for effective rehabilitation for serious juvenile offenders.

The amount of the grant is based on the number of persons under the age of 18 in the state.
