## RAHALL PRAISES SBA INITIATIVE

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- Congressman Nick J. Rahall, II (D-WV) today praised the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) West Virginia District Office for its proposed corporate procurement initiative which helps small businesses contact large corporations so they can supply goods or services.

Marvin P. Shelton of the SBA announced that they had contacted more than 90 contracting/purchasing agents of large businesses in West Virginia, and so far the reaction has been extremely favorable.
