RAHALL ANNOUNCES GRANT TO TIME OUT

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- CONGRESSMAN NICK J. RAHALL, II (D-WV) ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT AFTER URGING BY HIM, THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES HAS DECIDED TO ISSUE A GRANT TO THE SOUTHWESTERN COMMUNITY ACTION COUNCIL FOR THEIR "PROJECT TIME OUT" IN THE AMOUNT OF \$79,674. THAT IS \$12,015 MORE THAN THE "TIME OUT" GRANT FROM THE YEAR BEFORE.

"THE GRANT IS FOR THE TWELVE MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING JULY 1, 1989 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1990," EXPLAINED RAHALL.

"PROJECT TIME OUT" IS A PROGRAM THAT PROVIDES SHELTER AND COUNSELING FOR RUNAWAYS AND HOMELESS YOUTHS. THE APPROVED PROJECT DURATION IS FOR A THIRTY-SIX MONTH PERIOD, BEGINNING JULY 1, 1989 AND TERMINATING JUNE 30, 1992.

"CHILDREN ARE ONE OF OUR MOST TREASURED NATURAL RESOURCES," SAID RAHALL. "AND I CAN'T THINK OF MONEY MORE WELL SPENT THEN THAT GOING TO HELP THEM GET BACK ON THE RIGHT TRACK."
