RAHALL ANNOUNCES GRANT TO REGION I

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- CONGRESSMAN NICK J. RAHALL, II (D-WV) ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY HAS AWARDED A \$9,000 GRANT TO THE REGION I PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL FOR A UNIQUE PROJECT.

THE EPA "OUTREACH INCENTIVE GRANT" WILL PROVIDE MONIES TO BE USED FOR COMMUNITY EDUCATION. THROUGH THE USE OF VIDEO TAPES, THE PLANNING PROCESS AND DEVELOPMENTAL PROCEDURES FOR "SMALL FLOWS TECHNOLOGY" WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE COMMUNITIES TO HELP REDUCE CONSTRUCTION COSTS.

"THIS GRANT PROVIDES AN EXCELLENT OPPORTUNITY FOR COMMUNITIES TO WORK TOGETHER TO BETTER THEIR WATER RESOURCES," SAID RAHALL.

THE GRANT COMES UNDER THE CLEAN WATER ACT, SECTION 104, AS AMENDED.
