RAHALL ANNOUNCES MORE HUD FUNDING

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- CONGRESSMAN NICK J. RAHALL, II (D-WV) ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT A \$1.1 MILLION GRANT HAS BEEN AWARDED TO THE WASHINGTON SQUARE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON.

THE FUNDS WILL BE USED TO COMPLETE THE FINAL STAGES OF A MODERNIZATION PROJECT FOR EXISTING LOW-RENT FAMILY HOUSING.

WHEN ASKED WHAT HE THOUGHT OF THE HUD GRANT, CONGRESSMAN RAHALL REPLIED, "IT IS OBVIOUS THAT HUD IS TRYING TO MAKE UP FOR THE SINS OF THE PAST, AND I HOWEVER, WE STILL HAVE A LOT ENCOURAGE THEIR RESOLVE. OF NEGLECT TO MAKE UP FOR. TOO MANY LOW INCOME FAMILIES SUFFERED FOR FAR TOO LONG FOR US TO JUST ACCEPT A COUPLE OF GRANTS AND BE DONE WITH MY IT. OFFICE IS DOING EVERYTHING IN ITS POWER TO SEE THAT THIS WILL NOT BE THE LAST OF THESE TYPES OF FUNDS."
