WASHINGTON, D.C.-- U.S. REP. NICK RAHALL (D-WV) TODAY ANNOUNCED THAT TOMMI GRAY OF MAN, WEST VIRGINIA WILL SERVE AS HIS U.S. CONGRESSIONAL PAGE IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES BEGINNING JANUARY 28, 1990.

MISS GRAY WILL BE ENROLLED IN THE SPRING SESSION OF THE CONGRESSIONAL PAGE SCHOOL WHERE SHE WILL STUDY A CORE CURRICULUM OF MATH, ENGLISH, SCIENCE AND HISTORY. IN ADDITION TO HER ACADEMIC STUDIES, MISS GRAY WILL SERVE AS A CONGRESSIONAL PAGE AND LEARN, FIRST HAND, THE INNER WORKINGS OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

MISS GRAY IS CURRENTLY A JUNIOR AT MAN HIGH SCHOOL WHERE SHE MAINTAINS A 3.8 GRADE POINT AVERAGE. SHE IS A MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY AND WAS THE AMBASSADOR TO THE HUGH O'BRIAN YOUTH FOUNDATION STATE LEADERSHIP SEMINAR.
