MARSHALL MEDICAL SCHOOL AWARDED \$91,000 FEDERAL GRANT

WASHINGTON, DC -- U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV) announced today that the Marshall University School of Medicine's Department of Pharmacology was awarded a \$91,187 research grant from the National Institute of Diabetes and Digestive and Kidney Diseases.

The research grant will be used to study factors modulating cephaloridine nephrotoxicity.

"The research funded by this grant will be used to improve the health of West Virginians and all Americans," said Rahall.
